



If you were given one million dollars, where would you travel to? How would you spend that money?


He spent everything that he had 500n after that, the land became very dry, and there was no rain. There was not enough food to eat anywhere in the country. The son was hungry and needed money.


LUKE 15:15-16 ICB






The son realized that he had been very foolish. He though, 'All of my father's servants have plenty of food. But I am here, almost dying with hunger.

LUKE 15:18-19 ICB




So the son left and went to his father. While the son was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. He felt sorry for his son. So the father ran to him and hugged and kissed him

The son said, 'Father, I have sinned against God and against you. I am not good enough to be called your son.'


LUKE 15:21 ICB






But the father said to his servants, 'Hurry! Bring the best clothes and put them on him. Also put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet...
